mammal	A warm-blooded vertebrate animal that has hair or fur, females that secrete milk for the nourishment of the young, and (typically) the birth of live young.
amphibian	A cold-blooded vertebrate animal e.g. frogs, toads, newts, and salamanders. They are distinguished by having gills for breathing and start life as larvae.
insect	A small animal that has six legs and generally one or two pairs of wings.
compass	An instrument containing a magnetized pointer which shows the direction of magnetic north and bearings from it.
