Background Information

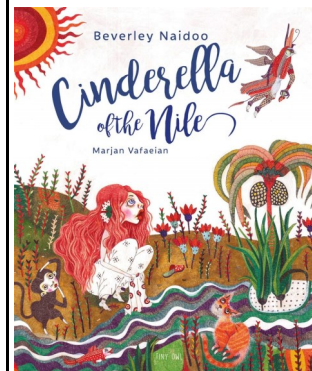
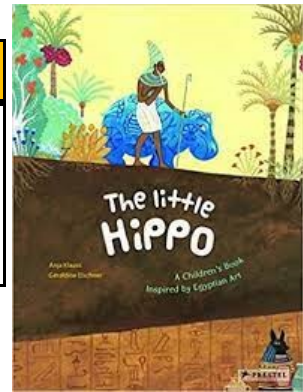
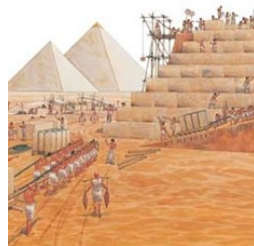

Skeletal system	All the bones in the human body together.
